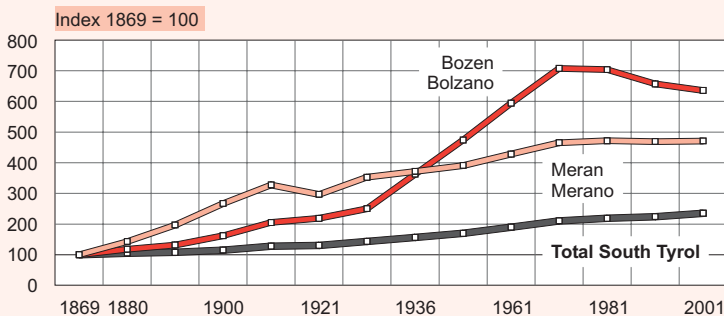

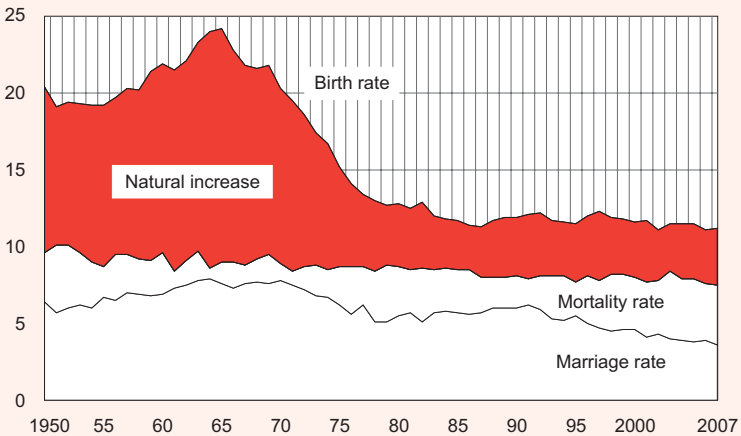

### Birth rate, mortality rate and marriage rate - 1950-2007 (per 1,000 inhabitants)



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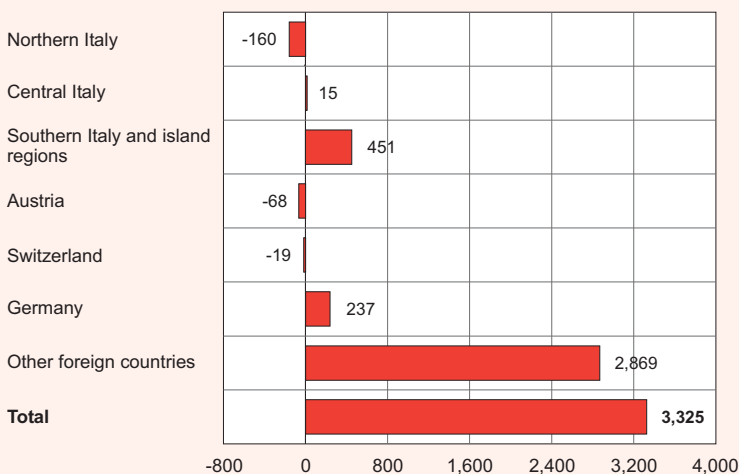

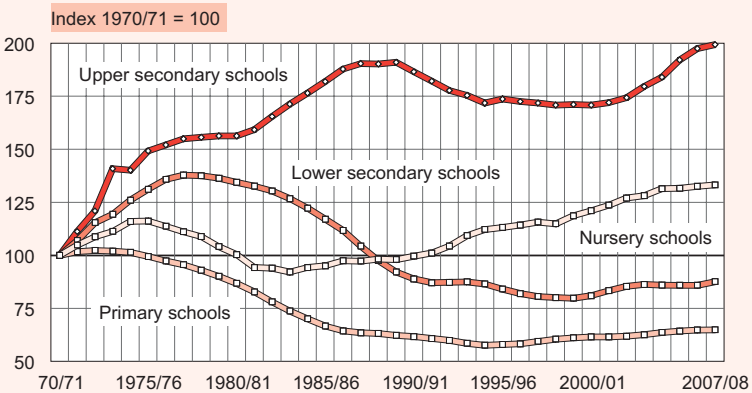

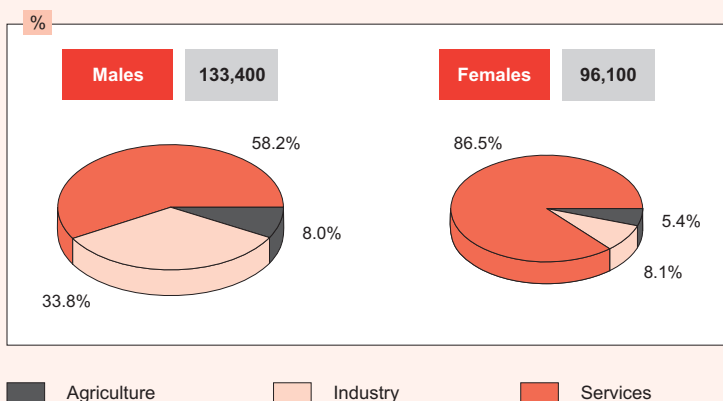

Percentage composition

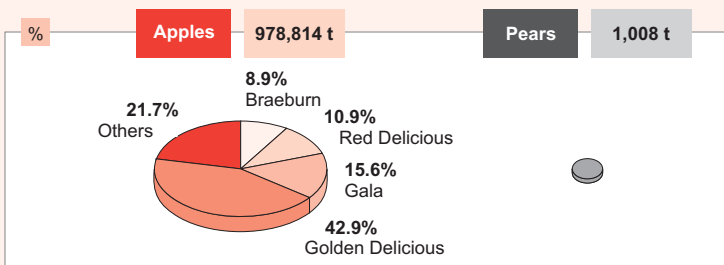

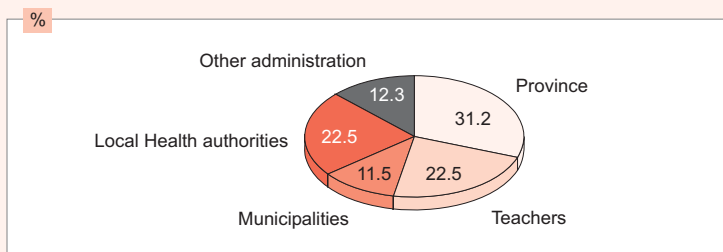
