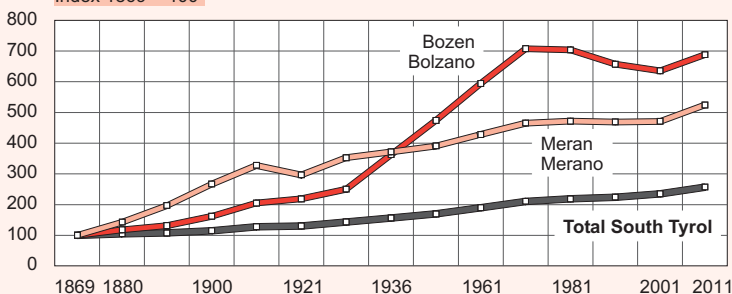

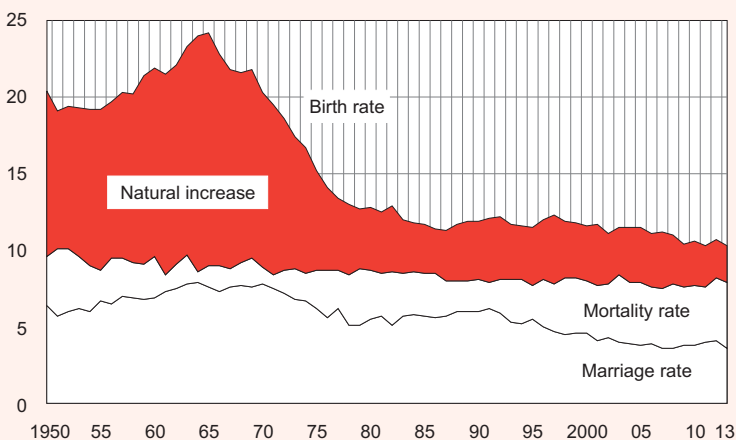

Migration balance by source and destination area - 2012

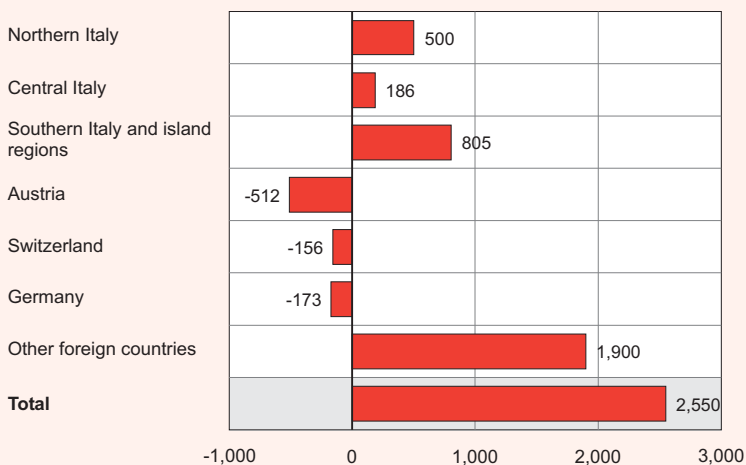

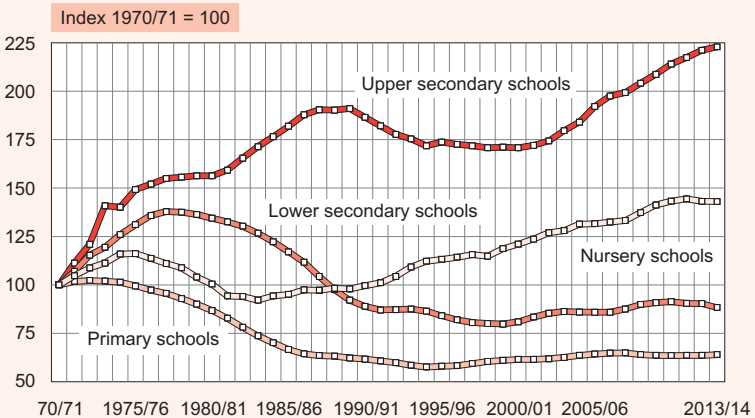

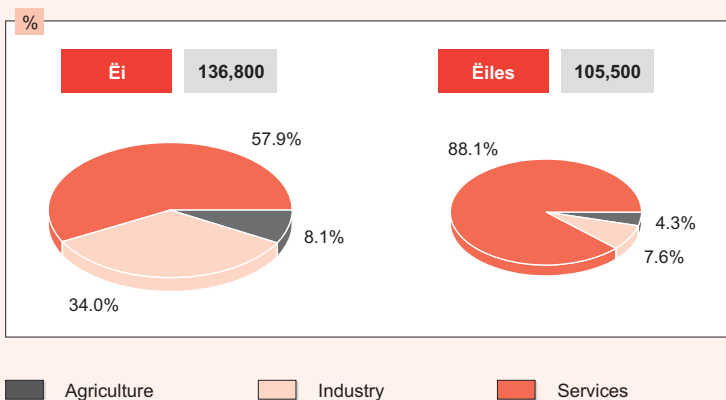

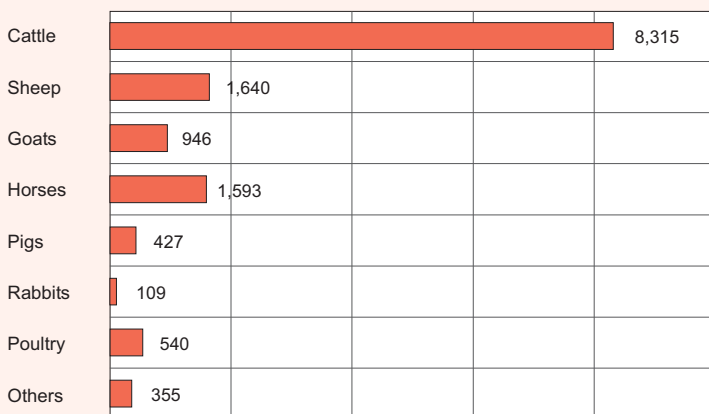

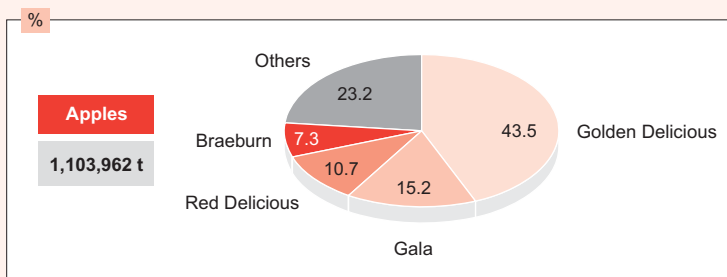

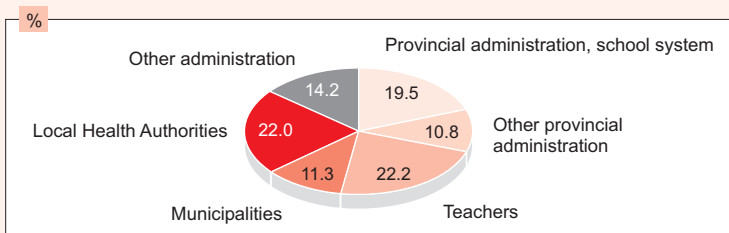
