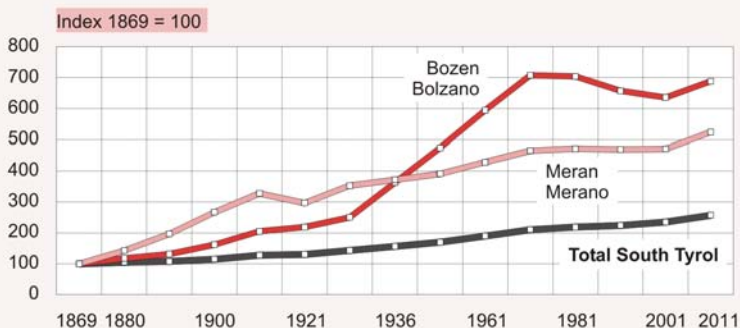

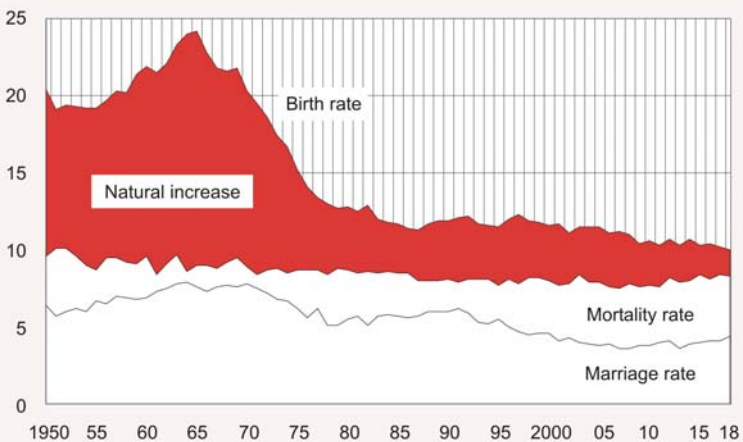

Migration balance by region of provenance and destination area - 2017

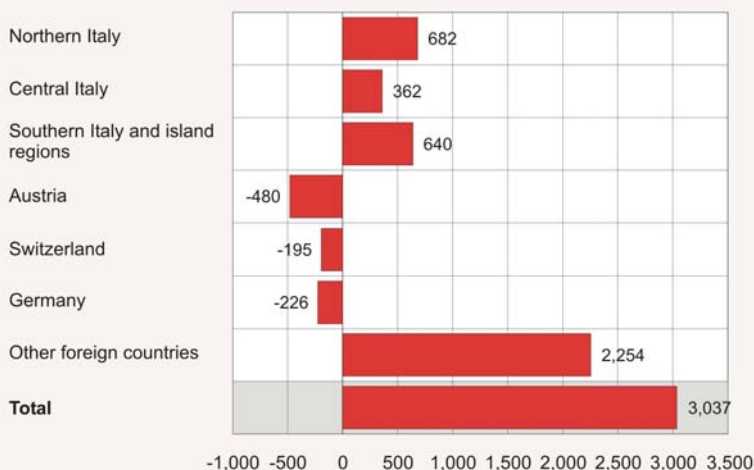

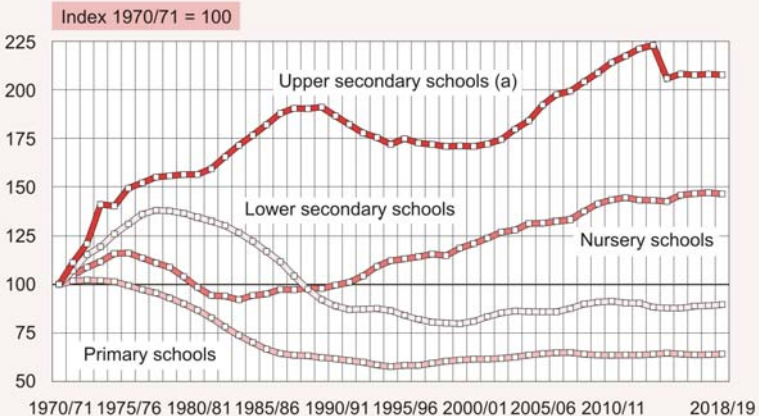

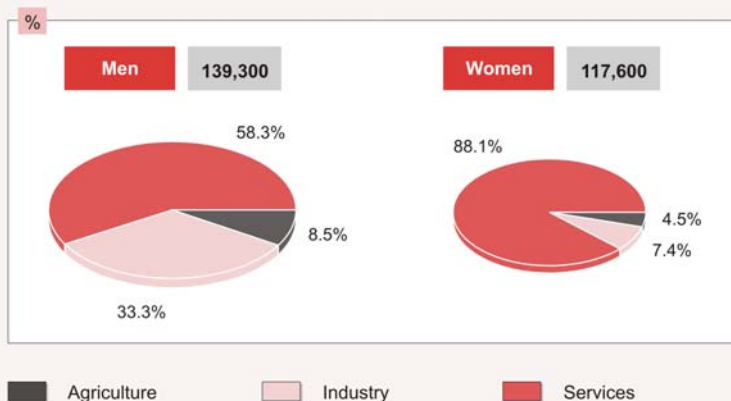

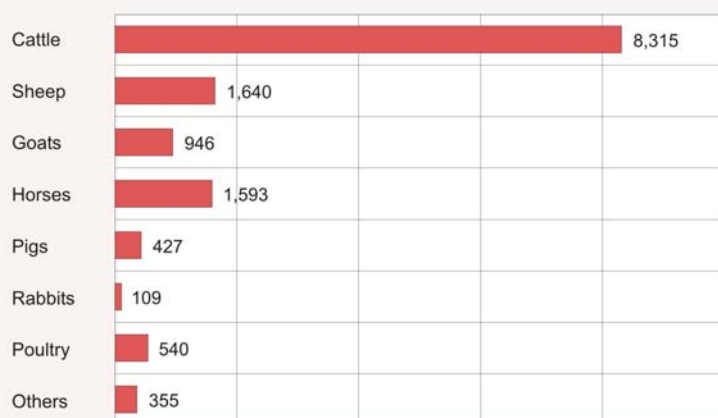

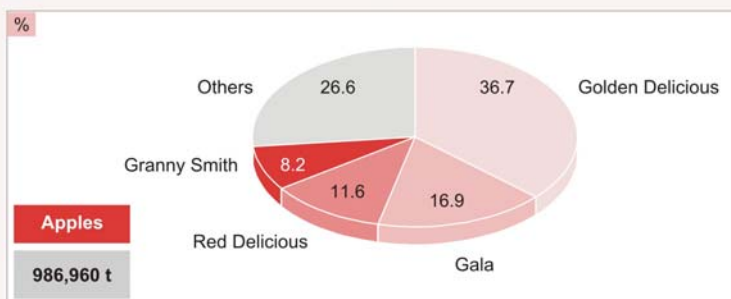

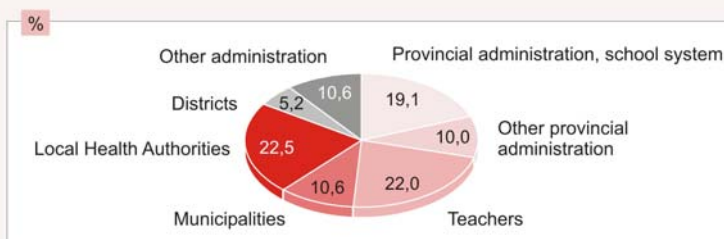
