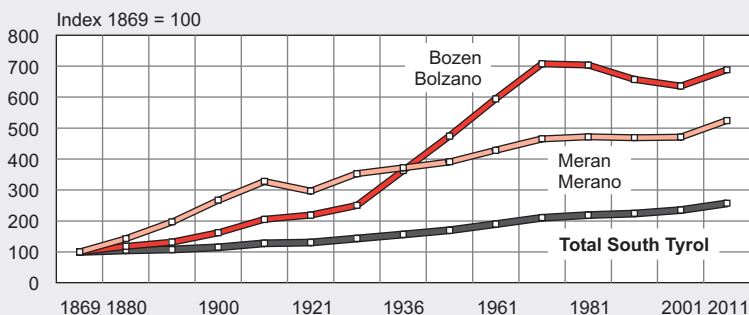

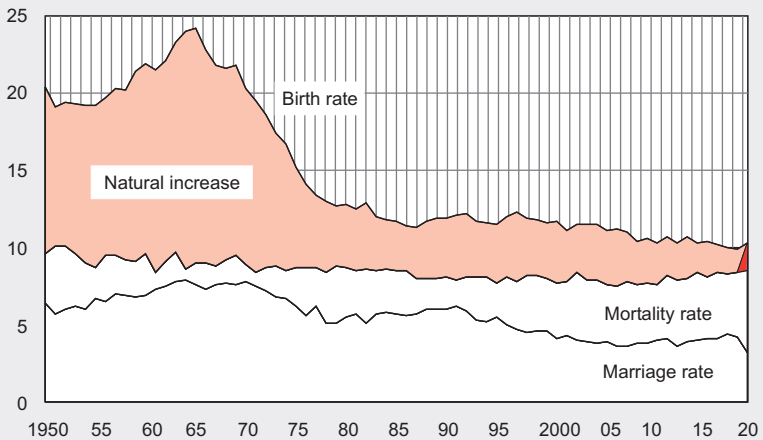

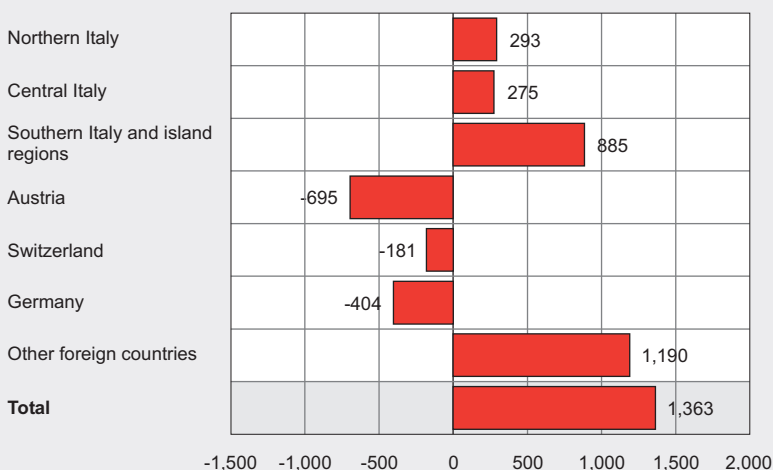
**Migration balance by region of provenance and destination area - 2019**

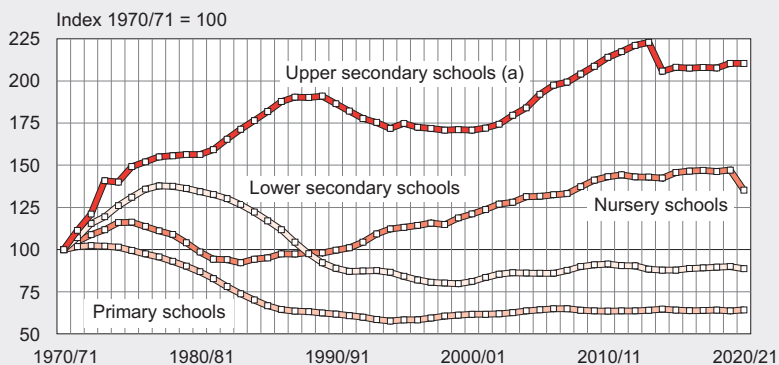

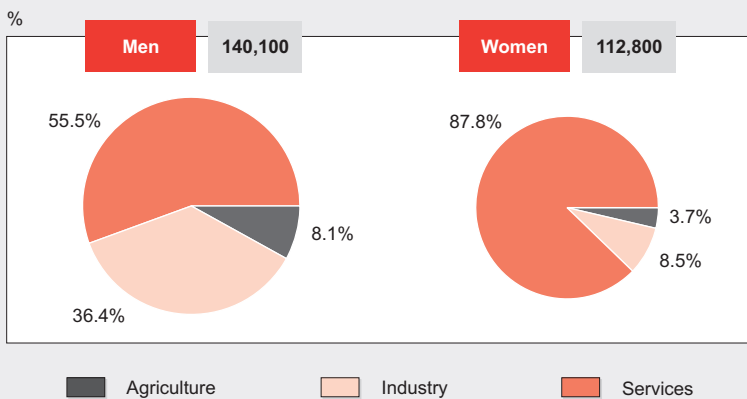

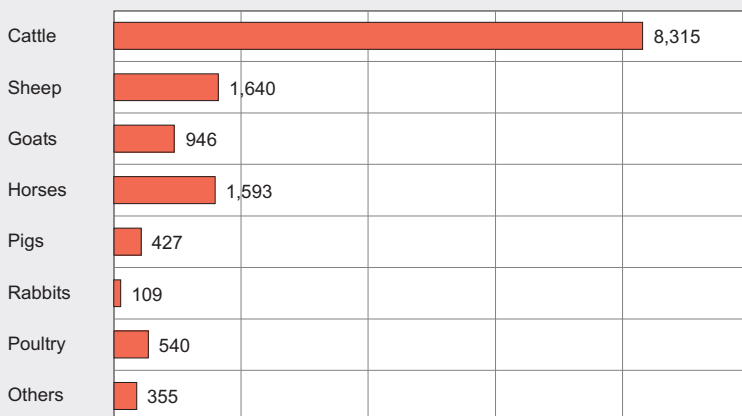
**Agricultural holdings by livestock type - Census of Agriculture 2010**

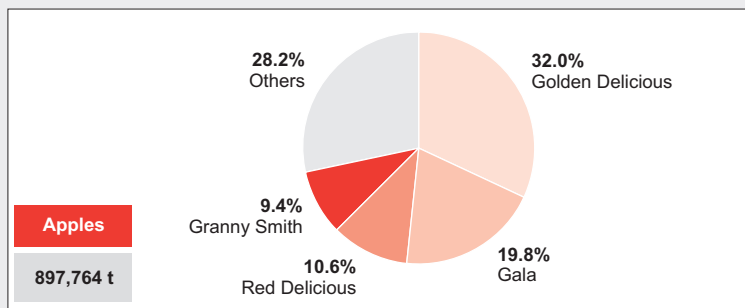

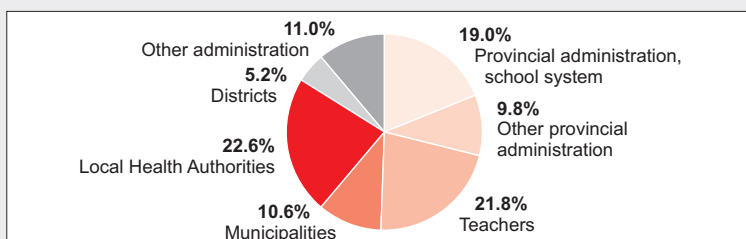
